Tournament for the "small stars"

In 2006, Cedric-Marcel Stebe reached the U16 doubles final of the Mercedes Junior Cup. At the end of 2009 he became German Champion, reached the Top 100 in 2011 and played his first Davis Cup match in 2012. In 2007, the twelve-year-old Russian Yulia Putintseva won the U14 category of the Mercedes Junior Cup. She reached the final of the Junior Australian Open in 2012 and entered the Top 200. At the age of 13, Belinda Bencic from Switzerland won the U16 category of the Mercedes Junior Cup. In February 2012, the now fifteen-year-old played her first Federations Cup match. This list could be continued for a long time: Ernests Gulbis (LET) and Andrey Golubev (KAZ), Alexandra Dulgheru and Irina Begu (both ROM) - all of them once participated at the Mercedes Junior Cup and are now in the professional tour. Therefore the Mercedes Junior Cup belongs to the Category 1 of the Tennis Europe Tour - and this year for the first time in both age categories as the only tournament in Europe.
